

# Pledged Giving at St. Andrews





## Where does the money go?

Throughout the year we spend nearly CHF 8,000 each week in keeping the Church going, and furthering our mission in our community.




Most of our expenses are dedicated to ensuring that the church is run in an effective manner, with our small clerical, administration, and maintenance team.

Our buildings require considerable upkeep and maintenance. In providing access to many people we must ensure they are safe, clean, and secure. In addition, we are keen to ensure that they can support our community well into the future.

We benefit from the support and guidance provided by the Diocese of Europe, and Archdeaconry of Switzerland. In return, we contribute financially to continue this work.

## Where does the money come from?

St. Andrew's does not receive any income from the Government, or the Church. All income is generated through our community and their good work. In addition, we look to use the assets we have to our financial advantage by generating rent, when they are not being used by our membership.



Nearly half of our income comes from the pledged giving within our community, with a further sixth in collections and donations. Over two thirds of our Electoral Roll members contribute via pledged giving.

The advantage of pledged income is that it is predictable. As we know what our community have committed to give us in advance, we can therefore plan how to use those funds with confidence.

## What can I do about it?

2020 has been a year unlike any other and will live long in people's memories. As a Church and a Community, we look forwards and try to understand what the "new normal" may be, much as we do as individuals.

For the church, we can develop and implement new activities with greater certainty if we have a reliable income from our community.

We invite all members to pray and reflect on their giving, in terms of financial, emotional, and practical support, and do what they can to support the Church.
